Eligibility:

Fast Coursing Ability Tests are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age on the day of the test that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. (go to www.AKC.org to register your canine companion)

Dogs with breed disqualifications and spayed/neutered dogs are eligible to enter. A dog may enter only once per Test.

Any dog that displays aggressive behavior during trial hours will be excused for the day without refund.

Paper entries may be mailed to the FTS. Email entries with PayPal payment will be accepted, send entries to and payments utahsighthounds@gmail.com with an additional \$2 per PayPal transaction to cover fees. The club can also process card payments during trial hours, please see the Club Treasurer for assistance.

Pre-entries must be received by the FTS prior to 6pm on Thursday, 23 September 2021. Entries will not be acknowledged by email, mail or telephone.

Late, incomplete, unsigned or conditional entries will not be accepted.

Directions:

Take I-15 exit #292 for 114000 South, head west until you reach the turnoff for the South Jordan Equestrian Park. The FastCAT running area will be between the LDS church building on 114th S and the private driveway into the Park.

Important Times:

Each day's two tests will be run concurrently, to accommodate entrants and volunteers. Inspections will begin at approximately 10am each day, and any exhibitors who are willing to commit to volunteering during the tests will be given preferred placement in the running order.

Note: Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at risk for injury and exhaustion. Bitches in season are not allowed near the test area during the hours of the trial. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.

Due to COVID safety concerns, all exhibitors must wear a mask and practice safe social distancing guidelines as laid out by the American Kennel Club for performance events.

Any exhibitor or participant who shows any sign of illness prior to or during the event will be asked to leave the trial site, and their entry fees will be refunded in full. Any exhibitor or participant unable or unwilling to adhere to the safety guidelines will be asked to leave the trial site.

Ribbon:

A light blue participation ribbon will be awarded for successful completion of the 100 yard run (dog must cross the finish line). New Title rosettes sponsored by USRCC will be available for all entrants who complete a title during the weekend.

Tests Offered:

AKC Fast CAT – The purpose of the AKC FAST CAT® event is to provide all dogs and their owners an enjoyable, healthy activity in which they can participate. Dogs run singularly. The dog's time to complete the 100 yard dash is converted into MPH. Dogs earn points based on their handicapped speed. Titles are awarded when a dog has accumulated a given number of points

General Information:

Battery powered machine and white plastic lure will be used. Backup equipment will be available. Time will be recorded using a laser timing system, with backup hand-timed stopwatches. **One dog handler is needed at both the start and finish line.** Please be sure your dog can be safely and quickly retrieved at the end of the Test. The field will be fully fenced.

A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose dog not competing while the FastCAT is in progress.

All participants are expected to clean up after their dogs. No exceptions! USRCC provides waste bags and dedicated receptacles for exhibitors.

USRCC expects all participants to adhere to the AKC Code of Sportsmanship at all times. Concerns or disputes may be brought to the Test Chairman for resolution.

USRCC and Salt Lake County Equestrian Event Center assumes no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during, or after the Test, including practice runs.
